



a short tale to teach a moral lesson, a story not founded on fact, a story about supernatural or extraordinary persons or incidents; legend, legends or myths collectively


























The exemplary story presents, not an analogy, but an example, one specific case which illustrates a general principle.

The Good Samaritan (Lk 10:29-37)

The Rich Fool (Lk 12:16-21);

The Pharisee and the Tax Collector (Lk 18:9-14).

- ☐ Concise
- ☐ Narrates a typical or recurrent event from real life.
- ☐ It tells a story which everyone would recognize as a familiar experience.
- ☐ No one, on hearing a similitude, is likely to deny this is the way life is.
- Compares dissimilar things.

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Such is how anyone would rejoice on finding a lost coin (Lk 15:8-10)




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
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

"After a long time the master of those servants returned and settled accounts with them. The man who had received five bags of gold brought the other five. 'Master,' he said, 'you entrusted me with five bags of gold. See, I have gained five more.'

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"So take the bag of gold from him and give it to the one who has ten bags. For whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. And throw that worthless servant outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

Taken at face value this parable is telling us that God wants us to double our money. If we don't then we are evil and will not be accepted into Heaven.

The next level of interpretation might be this parable is telling us God has given us talents, gifts, skills and abilities. We are expected to use those talents and produce converts or we will be in big trouble.

The problem is: we never hear the master communicating any expectation, responsibility, obligation or even an order to obey.
