





Isaiah 66:22 "As the new heavens and the new earth that I make will endure before me," declares the Lord, "so will your name and descendants endure.


Increasing importance placed on the words

God guided the process so that what the writers wrote down contains the Word of God God guided the process so that the very words written down were the Word of God


Principle #2: Interpret literally when possible




Romans 7:4-6
